Qualifications for all positions:

- Must be a member in good standing.
- Must be available to participate in Board and Membership meetings, as well as pertinent APTA meetings

Minimum expectation for participation:

- Attend quarterly Board of Directors (BOD) meetings held via zoom (typically 2 hours in the evening)
- Attend in-person Winter Membership Meeting held in December
- Complete position objectives as outlined below
- Attend ad hoc committee meetings on a PRN basis

Nominating Committee Member	3 years Committee Member for 2 years, Chair in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> year	10-12 hours, mostly in March-September	Lead the effort to fill vacant positions in the Maine Chapter.
